COASTERS TO FORE AT CHAMPIONSHIPS

Two Tasmanian motorcyclists finished in the top six at the Australian Observed Sporting Trial championships held at Loongana yesterday.

They were the reigning Tasmanian champion Owen Badcock, of Moriarty, who finished equal third, and John Holmes, of Devonport, who was sixth.

Reigning titleholder Chris Leighfield, of Victoria, retained his title with a brilliant performance on his Montana.

Leighfield, with 81 points lost, easily won the title from Queensland rider David Pinkerton on a Yamaha, who lost 132 points.

The results are subject to ratification today.

"Leighfield was absolutely brilliant — he had to be seen to be believed," said Mr. Don Naden, secretary of the North - Western Motor Cycle Club, which conducted the titles.

"Even the other competitors were amazed at his ability," Mr. Naden said.

Leighfield, an ex-Englishman, frequently finished in the top 10 in championships in England.

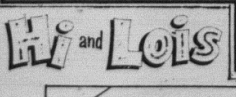
Mainland officials and competitors described it as one of the hardest and one of the best championships ever staged, Mr. Naden said.

"This is a pat on the back for Tasmanian motorcycling, and the North - West in particular."

"The standard of riding was far higher than ever seen previously in Tasmania."

"That two Tasmanians finished in the top six, speaks highly for the ability of local riders," he said.

The large crowd of about 600 was a pleasant surprise for officials.
